Just £5 every month can help keep the Braintree Area Foodbank providing food to those in need in the community.

What is a Foodbank?

Foodbanks work to support people who find themselves on the edge of a crisis.

When people have no financial safety net, a sudden crisis, such as bereavement, benefit delay, redundancy or illness, can leave them unable to feed themselves or their family.

Such situations can quickly deteriorate, leading to relationship breakdown, house repossession or worse.

Foodbanks can help to bridge the gap while more permanent support is put in place.

How does a Foodbank work?

Foodbanks rely on donations of food from the community. Individuals, or local organisations acting as collection points, bring donated food to the main collection point which are then sorted by volunteers and packed into boxes. Foodbanks partner with front-line care

professionals, who identify people in crisis and give them a voucher. On taking their voucher to a Foodbank Distribution Centre in the Braintree area, people receive a warm welcome, a drink and a food parcel. We also signpost people with agencies who can help to resolve the underlying causes of the crisis.

Why do we need Supporters?

Braintree Area Foodbank can only continue to provide people in crisis with a lifeline through the help and support of the local community.

Regular support by Standing Order means we can plan our work, giving Braintree Area Foodbank the confidence that comes from regular income.

If we can find 100 people willing to donate £5 every month, this would give us £500 per month—that's £6,000 per year.

Money raised will be used for the day to day running expenses of the Foodbank.
