

**The following is a precis of the Minutes of the PCC Meeting held 20<sup>th</sup> September 2017.**

Remembrance Sunday would follow the same pattern as in previous years but arrangements are being made for a special centenary service next year. A copy of the 1918 Parish Magazine has been obtained and the suggestion was made to request a loan of appropriate items from the museum to display in Church for the service.

It was agreed to request advice from the Diocese regarding maintenance of the Churchyard. A grant has been obtained from the District Council for use on the Churchyard or Burial Ground.

A number of PCC members will need to renew their DBS clearance.

A plan is in place so that the Church will be open for special prayers should there be a major event or disaster.

There will be a United Benefice Service at All Saints' Feering at 10 a.m. on Sunday, 24<sup>th</sup> December.

A faculty request has been made for the repairs to the north clerestory.

A suitable cordless vacuum cleaner would be purchased.

Redundant kneelers and chairs have been obtained from Chelmsford Cathedral.

Enquiries are being made with regard to the organ that will need major repairs.

Church finances are at break-even point.

The new Book Club is proving very successful and enjoyable.

A Teaching Eucharist is planned for November.
